Ready to eat! Guests in our Permanent Housing Program gather outside Golden Corral where they enjoyed a special dinner treat! Great time to socialize and try new foods.



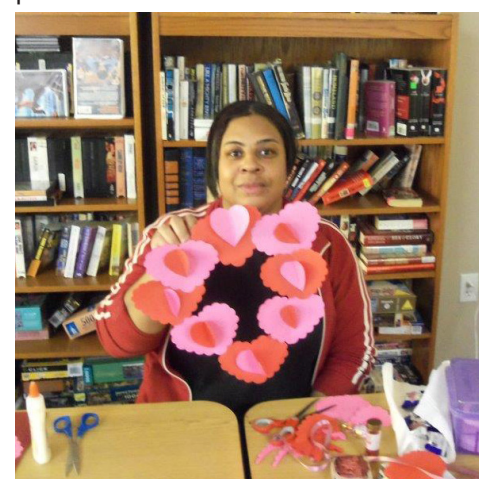
### FAITHFUL VOLUNTEERS IN ACTION

Students from Rockford Christian showed their commitment to service while working at Carpenter's Place this month. Their energy and efforts were greatly appreciated.

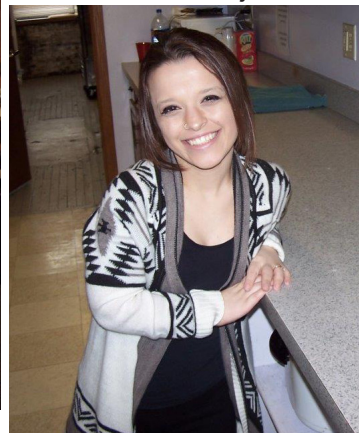


**TEAMWORK WORKS!**
