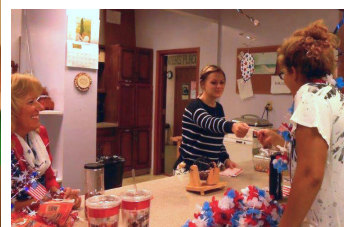
ACCOUNTABILITY
