Paul, an intern in our Employment Program detailed the CP van to perfection. He is now using his great work ethic at a new job gained in June. Way to go, Paul!

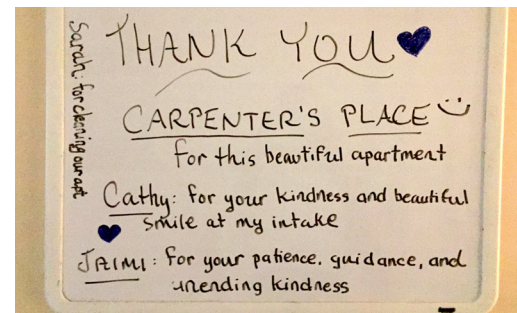
