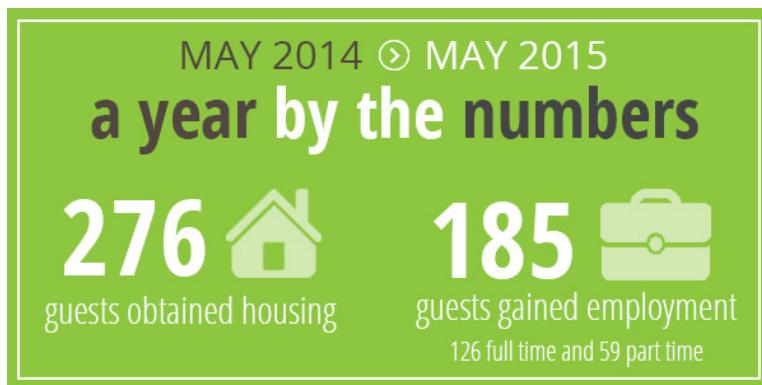
On a Roll
