Our two newest employees, Teresa and Judy, were Rockford proud on 8/15.



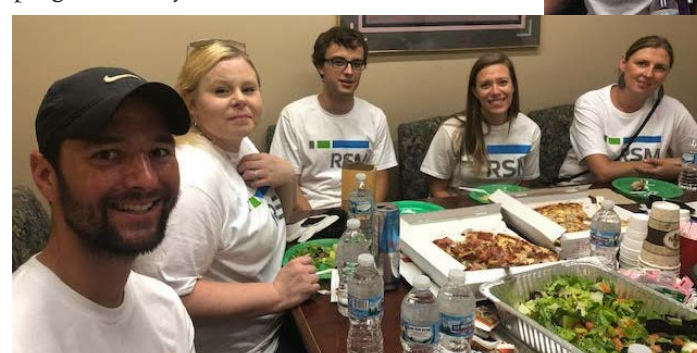
A WONDERFUL SUMMER LUNCH
