Wade was very grateful to receive a bike, helmet, light and lock.



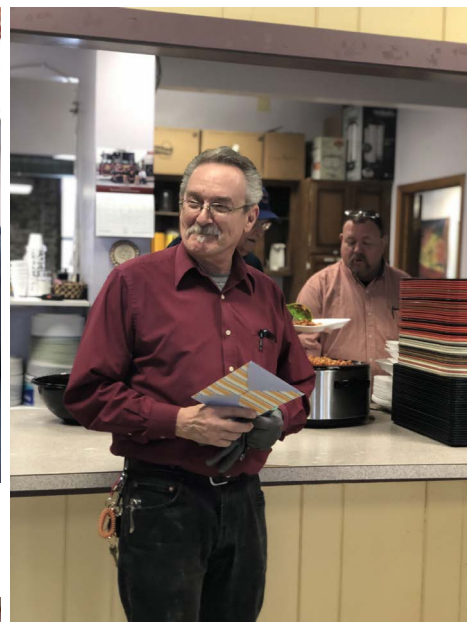
A BOUNTIFUL BREAKFAST
