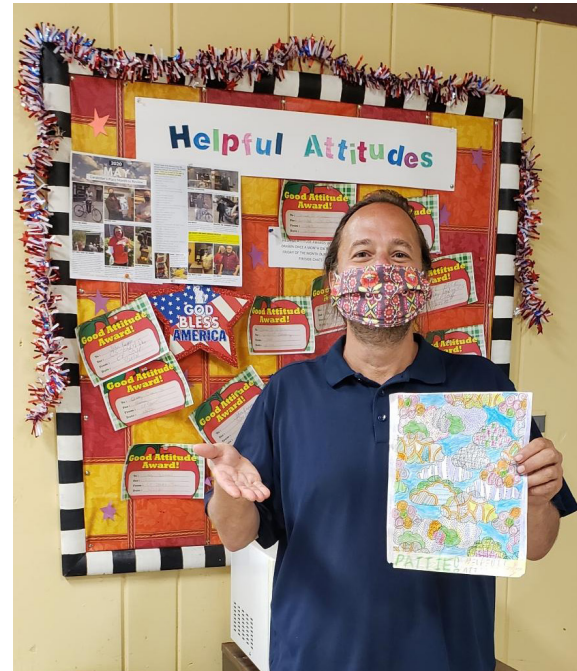

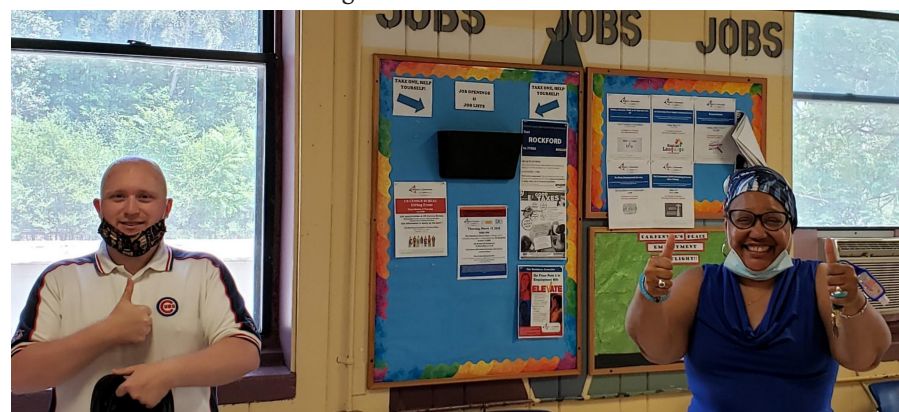
BREAKFAST DROP-OFF

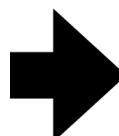
