A CLOSER LOOK AT OUR DAY ROOM

Carpenter's Place day center is open during the week for homeless men and women to have a place to feel safe and comfortable. Our dayroom offers bathrooms, showers, storage for personal belongings, laundry service, needed items, mail delivery, and meals (breakfast and lunch). We also offer devotions, bible study, arts and crafts time, as well as other events through the year. The primary service of CP is comprehensive and holistic case management. When our guests meet with case managers, they work on a "Life Recovery Plan" which serves as a roadmap to positive life changes.
