The perfect hoodie for Egypt to have worn in this moment! Those words could not have been more perfect to have branded across her chest than today.

Egypt came to the Family Service Program about a year ago. She was pregnant and homeless, couch surfing without a permanent place to call home. She could not focus on her health, which was a concern as she had a high-risk pregnancy. The stress of her situation caused her to deliver her baby 2 months early and he spent several weeks in the neonatal intensive care unit.

Egypt worked diligently on her service plan goals with the support of her case manager. She enrolled in a GED program and worked on obtaining permanent stable housing. Egypt was finally blessed with the keys to her new home. Her challenges to find stable housing for her now 1 year old son have ended, and her smile that could light up a room says it all.



BUILDING A BETTER LIFE

Tim became homeless in 2018, sometimes staving in a motel or with a friend, but most often he lived on the streets. Occasionally, he was able to work odd jobs. In early 2023, Tim was having a particularly rough day wandering the streets. He said a prayer, asking God to help him find some work today. Soon thereafter, he heard a vehicle pull up behind him, and the driver called him over. It just happened to be a former employer from years ago, asking if he was looking for work. This answered prayer has turned into a good paying, full-time job!

Currently. Tim is staving at a house owned by his employer. doing renovations in exchange for rent. Tim continues to utilize the CP day room for showers and a meal before going to work. Tim recently met one of his goals and opened a bank account and is saving for a truck. Our case management team continues to provide encouragement and help Tim reach his other goals. Tim's engagement with case management shows his commitment to self-improvement and goal achievement. By seeking assistance and guidance, he is taking proactive steps toward building a better life for himself.



TRANSPORTATION FOR SUCCESS

A lack of transportation is one of the biggest challenges for homeless adults trying to rebuild their lives. A reliable bicycle provides a mode of transportation to work, necessary appointments, and support meetings. Through the Cycle for Change program,


