RELYING ON FAITH - MICHELLE'S SUCCESS STORY

After completing school, Michelle moved back to Rockford to be closer to family, including her adult children. When her truck broke down, she worked some hours at a gas station and paired it with her remaining tax money to pay for the repairs. Shortly after, her temporary living situation ended and Michelle found herself homeless. Looking for help, she came to Carpenter's Place in April 2025. She was determined in her pursuit of success. She wanted to give up many times, but kept telling herself "Things don't always come when you want them to, but when they should - in God's timing." She filled out job applications, went to job fairs, and kept her case manager heavily involved. "You will get a lot of doors that will close, but you have to keep going until the door opens".

Her strength and determination paid off. Michelle recently started a job at Hennig, and has submitted an application to our women's housing program. "You have to rely on faith - Pray constantly, in good times and in bad. And always remember that everything is a learning lesson."



TRANSPORTATION FOR DENNIS

Transportation is one of the biggest challenges for homeless adults trying to rebuild their lives. A reliable bicycle provides a mode of transportation to work, appointments, and support meetings. Carpenter's Place provides guests in our housing programs, like Dennis, a bike (along with a bike light and lock).

Upon exiting the Family Service Program, Sharnita has established secure, stable housing and was offered a job with the school transportation service starting in August!
