Guillermo lost his apartment due to his mental health challenges. He was not managing his mental health as directed and taking his medication, which directly affected his ability to see his seven-year-old son. Guillermo found out that his son had been placed in DCFS custody and this influenced Guillermo's journey of getting back on track with the hope of gaining custody of his son. Guillermo began receiving mental health services, taking his medication, and going to support groups twice a week. Guillermo says he feels much better now and is grateful to see his son twice a week. He settled into his apartment he moved into in May and received furniture from CP. "I am appreciative of all the help I have received. Carpenters Place is a very good place that helps people when they need it." Said Guillermo.
